- The following are the rights of a roommate:
1. The right to sleep without disturbance from noise, guests of roommate(s), etc.
 2. The right to expect that a roommate will respect one's personal belongings.
 3. The right to a clean environment.
 4. The right to free access to one's room and facilities without pressure from the roommate.
 5. The right to privacy, including the right to exclude non-residents from the room.
 6. The right to address grievances.
 7. The right to be free from fear of intimidation and physical or emotional harm.
 8. The right to expect reasonable cooperation and the use of "room shared" appliances (refrigerator, fan, etc.).
 9. The right to seek help with the roommate relationship from Office of Residential Life Staff.
